Annual Academic Review


- Review your current room inventory
 - Are any of your rooms going through renovations?
 - Have any additional rooms or buildings been brought online?
- Are your scheduling preference rules still accurate?
 - Have any new courses been introduced that require a certain room type or features?
 - Are your courses and instructors still relevant?



Annual Event Review

- Review event types
 - Events for Selected Event Type
 - Are there a small amount of events tied to a certain event type?
 - Are your event types too generic?
 - Would another level of granularity with event meeting types benefit your reporting?
- Review your event request forms
 - Identify areas for improvement
 - Hyperlink or integrate your room reservation policy
- Review calendar filters related to events

Event Planning

- Review your room reservation policy and expectations
 - If you don't have one, then develop one!
- Create an event scheduling checklist for your requestors to help them plan their event
- Build help documentation with answers to FAQs you may receive
- Add Room Images
 - Leverage a student worker or student in a photography class to photography your event spaces on-campus
